Position Profile

The Student Leadership Council Representative serves their department area by acting as a voting member of the ACADSA governing Board.

Primary Objectives

The SLC Representative contributes to the organization by fulfilling the following objectives:

- 1. Representing the student voice from their department area on arising issues
- 2. Ensuring that the Association's affairs are conducted according to the governing documents of the Association
- 3. Promoting the general welfare of ACAD students in alignment with ACADSA's mission, vision, and mandate
- 4. Providing guidance on the direction and strategic growth of the Association

Responsibilities of the Position

The SLC Representative is directly responsible for carrying out the following tasks:

- 1. Representing the student voice from their department area on arising issues
 - a. Be available to students within their constituency to discuss any concerns or issues
 - b. Represent the best interests of the students in their constituency while keeping in mind the best interests of the community as a whole
 - c. Attend all meetings of the SLC
 - d. Post their name, SLC position and contact information on the department bulletin

- board within their constituency
- e. Vote and contribute to discussion of issues arising and presented at SLC meetings

2. Ensuring that the Association's affairs are conducted according to the governing documents of the Association

- a. Be knowledgeable about ACADSA Bylaws and Policies and Procedures
- b. Update constituency members on all relevant ACADSA business and inform them in how to access more information ie. minutes, meeting schedules, contact information etc.
- c. Approve recommendations from the ACADSA standing committees including but not limited to:
 - i. Annual Budget
 - ii. Policies and Bylaws
 - iii. Referenda
 - iv. Student Group Ratification and Funding

3. Promoting the general welfare of ACAD students in alignment with ACADSA's mission, vision, and mandate

- a. Act as an ambassador during activities hosted by the association
- Hold a Representative introductory meeting (or EC approved substitution) within the first three weeks of the first SLC meeting which must have at least one EC member present
- c. Communicate regularly with department members to remain aware of any issues and concerns arising

4. Providing guidance on the direction and strategic growth of the Association

- a. Submit a monthly written report utilizing the ACADSA template on department activities
- b. Serve on at least two ACADSA committees as required
- c. Participate in the annual board orientation and strategic planning retreat
